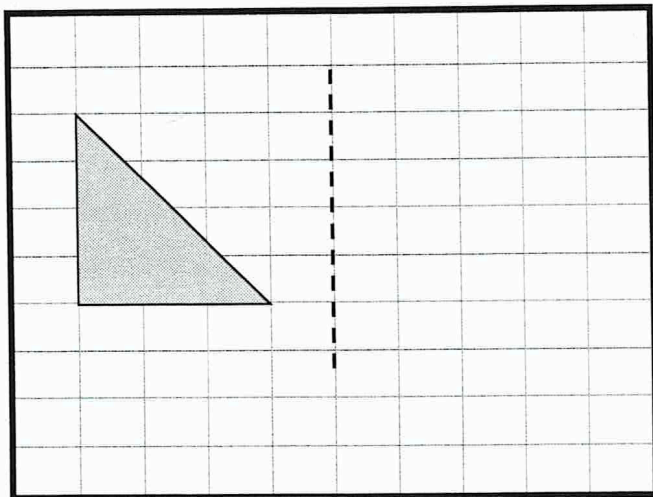


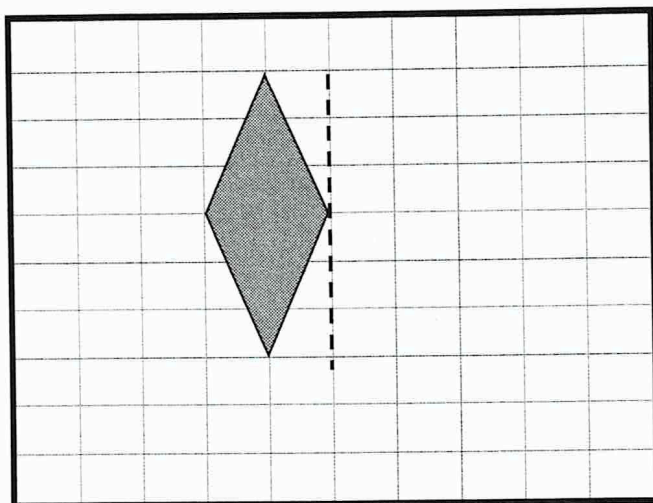

1. In each diagram below the dotted line is an axis of symmetry. Copy and complete each shape.

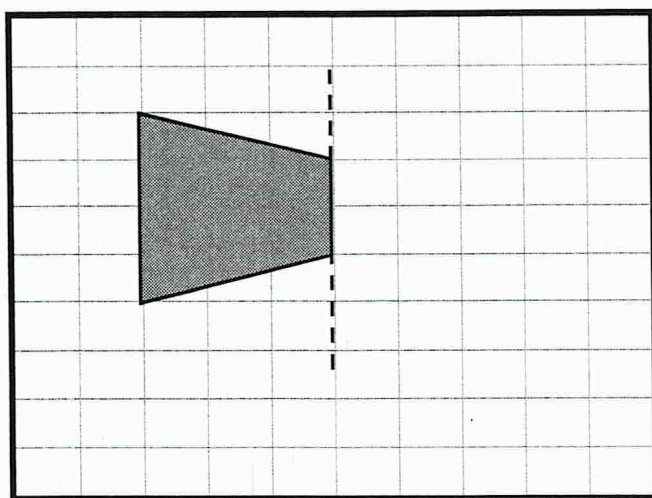

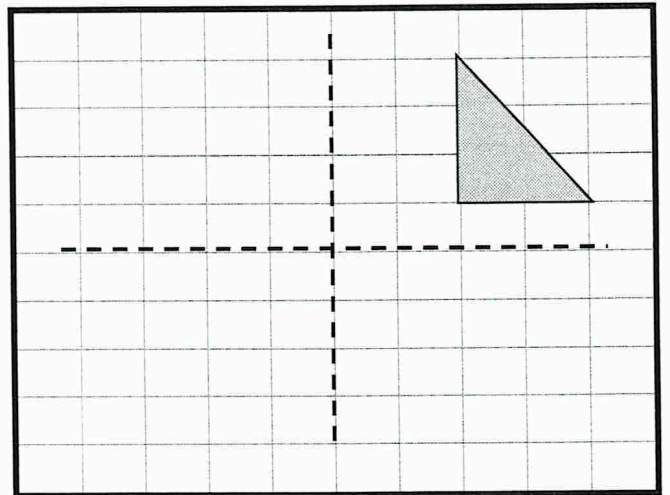


2. In each question below, each shape has two axes of symmetry, shown as dotted lines. Copy and complete each shape.

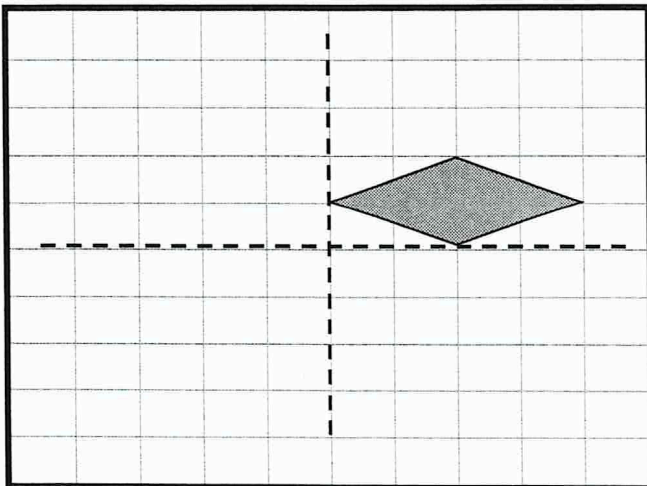

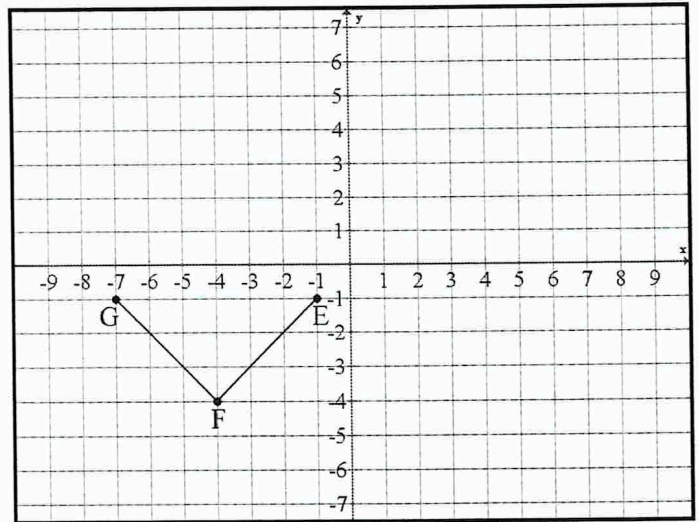
5. In the diagram opposite, AB and BC are two sides of a parallelogram ABCD.

6. The points E(-1,-1), F(-4,-4) and G(-7,-1) are shown opposite.

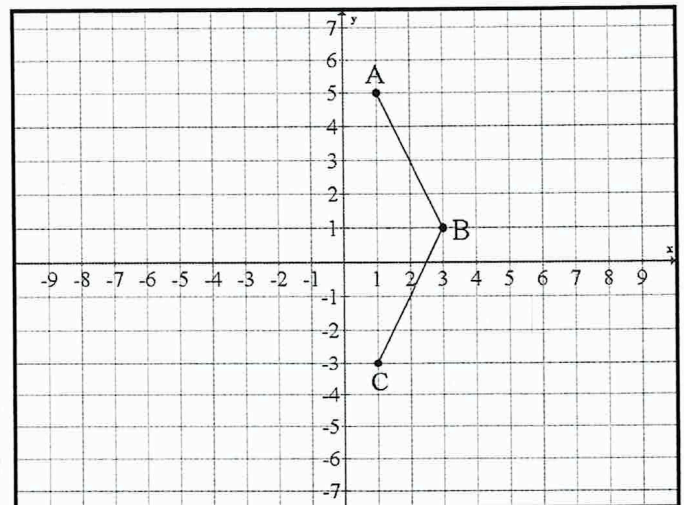
- Copy the diagram and plot H so that EFGH is a square.

A has coordinates (1,5), B is (3,1) and C is (1,-3).

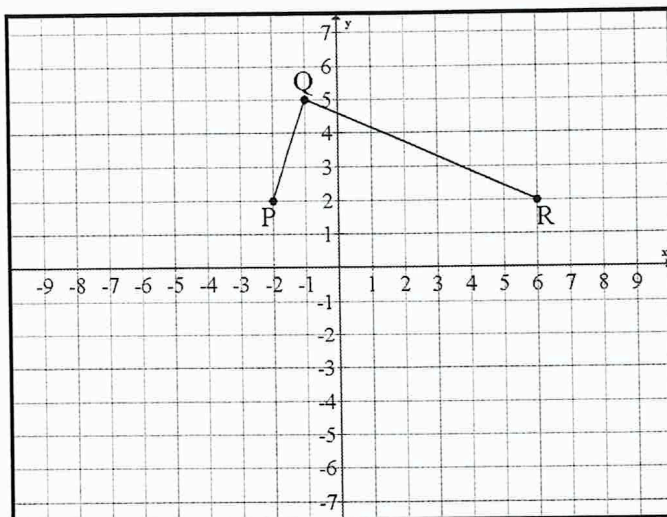
- Copy the diagram and plot the point D.

(a) Copy the diagram and find S given PQRS is a kite.

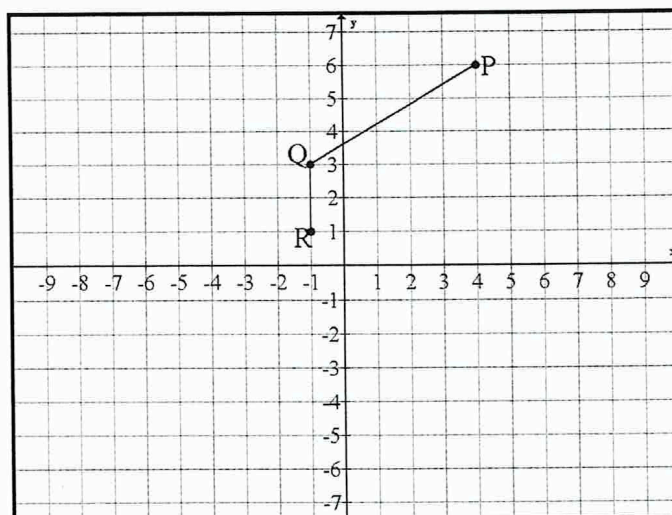
(b) Reflect PQRS in the y-axis.
